

Town Council Meeting
January 28, 2019
Westport Town Hall

The Westport Town Council met in special session at the Westport Town Hall, with the following present; Bryan Gatewood, President, Richard Smith, Joyce Brindley, Ronda Bartlett and Gloria Alunnbaugh. Bryan Gatewood called the meeting to order at 5:01 pm. President Gatewood began the meeting by opening bid packets for the Sewer Storm Drain Project at the intersection of Main street and Highway 3.


The following bid packets were opened:

Wright Excavating:	58,984


The town council reviewed all bid packets and President Gatewood asked Wright how soon they could start on the project. Wright stated that they could start the project mid-February. Commonwealth Engineer Roger Kottowski reviewed the bid packets and stated that Wright did not submit the proper paperwork which disqualified their bid. CF-1&M Excavating stated that they could start the project by the end of the week and included all required paperwork in their packet. Joyce made a motion to accept the bid from CH&M Excavating and Richard seconded the motion. Roger stated that his secretary, Nancy would send an award letter to CH&M tomorrow so that they can get started.

David and Linda Mazingo stated their concerns about the removal of gravel from the lake on their property and Roger reassured them that line items were included in the bid packet to cover appropriate gravel removal.

Richard made a motion to close the meeting, seconded by Joyce.
